

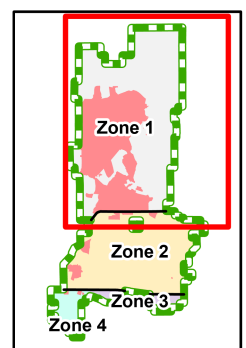
Appendix H to Fort McCoy
Regulation 420-29

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Fort McCoy has Land Rehabilitation and Maintenance (LRAM) sites in training areas on the installation. LRAM sites are clearly marked with red and white signs and yellow LRAM tape. Seibert stakes (red and yellow in color) are used to mark the perimeter of sensitive areas; a black vertical stripe on the stake indicates you are within the site. DO NOT DRIVE within, DIG, or DISTURB any LRAM sites and obey posted signs.

Vehicle traffic is PROHIBITED on the Fort McCoy boundary and NIA firebreak, unless there is an established road or trail, which are depicted on this map.
